PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Eight day non-credit summer program.

St. Louis Adult Learning and Continuing Education Centres offers a Literacy / Math program in the summer for students who are presently in grade 7 and 8 and are at risk of not meeting the expectations of the Ontario Curriculum and could benefit from additional teaching support in developing learning strategies in both Numeracy and Literacy.

The program is academic in nature focusing on the skills necessary for success in the Ontario Curriculum. This program benefits those students who have been achieving at a level 1 or 2 on the provincial report card. For those entering secondary school, this is excellent preparation for the grade 9 curriculum.

Literacy will focus on developing reading comprehension and writing strategies.

Numeracy will focus on order of operations, measurement, algebra, and computational skills.

This program is taught by experienced certified teachers in a classroom setting.

Teaching strategies, including use of computers and small groups, will increase student involvement and learning.

STUDENT ACCEPTANCE

Students must have approval of their elementary principal to be accepted.

There is no charge for the program, but the funding from the Ministry of Education does not allow for one-on-one instruction. For this reason, this program is not suitable for students on an IEP who receive one-on-one support during the school year or have behaviour exceptionalities.

Students are enrolled upon receipt of their application form. No confirmation is sent to student's school or parents. Unless students and parents are notified otherwise, they should plan to attend the first day.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided to elementary students and is dependent on number of students registered at each Catholic Elementary School within the K/W and Cambridge city limits. Information and transportation timetables will be made available through the student's elementary school by approximately **June 20th**.

REGISTRATION

Elementary students register at their home school and completed registrations are to be forwarded to St. Louis Adult Learning Centre (Cambridge).

Elementary students from other school boards are welcome to attend. Please send completed registration forms to St. Louis Adult Learning Centre (Cambridge)
